## Health Insurance Renewal Rates





The Ohio Board of Regents issued notice that Southern State Community College has been recommended for a funding award through the Workforce Development Equipment and Facility program. The award amount is \$243,000, which will be used for needed upgrades to TDA equipment such as tractors, trailers, power utility trucks, and school buses.

Enrollment trends are encouraging. Through the date this report was issued, 22 have begun training in April, with another 10 scheduled to be added yet this month. With
